

Park of the Pines (PoP) Community Camping Event Rules

The mission of Park of the Pines is to proclaim Jesus Christ and promote communities of love, hope, joy, and peace by providing a place for experiences that include camping, fellowship, worship, recreation, or personal development.

The fee for camping is \$35 per campsite/cabin per night payable to Park of the Pines via online (credit card only,) in-person cash or check paid to host camper at time of arrival.

The Host Camper may ask anyone using the campground to leave if they are not following posted rules, damaging campground property, violating laws, or causing a disturbance.

*Each site must be registered to an adult age 18yrs or older who will be staying on the site and be responsible for and ensure the supervision of any campers listed on the registration form.

1. All participants must register either on-line or with the campground host upon arrival. Check-in time with Host begins at 12pm on the day of arrival and check-out time is by 12:00pm the day of departure.
2. Each campsite is limited to one (1) camper/RV/trailer and one (1) tent or two (2) tents. No more than six (6) people per site unless approved by the camping host. Up to two (2) vehicles (not including a motorhome/camper) may be at each camp site.
3. All children under 18yrs of age must be supervised by a responsible adult/guardian at **all times**.
4. **Possession of fireworks (including sparklers), firearms, fixed or switched blade knives, any other weapons, alcohol, tobacco products, marijuana, illegal drugs or other controlled substances or their imitations are strictly forbidden. You must exit the grounds to smoke.**
5. Pets must be on a leash or secured at all times when outside a trailer, tent, or vehicle. Pets are not allowed in any buildings, or in the designated beach area.
6. All fires **MUST** be contained in fire ring and **COMPLETELY** extinguished when unattended. Host Camper has right to put out any campfire deemed unsafe.
7. Campsites must be kept clean with all trash and pet waste bagged, tied, and placed in designated receptacles.
8. No swimming available. Young State Park is just down the road.
9. Quiet hours are from 10:00pm to 8:00am.
10. Gambling and the use of horses, ATVs, ORVs, and motor boats is not allowed.
11. Any unclaimed items left behind will be held temporarily then disposed of after 10 days.
12. Please only use straps for hammocks as to not injure the trees.
13. Buildings on the upper terrace only are available (bathroom/shower house.) Do not enter other buildings on the grounds.

All other buildings on the property are off limits and should not be entered or used in any manner. Campers are encouraged but not required to participate in the daily ministry events announced and offered by the Host Camper. **Contact the Host Camper** with any questions or facility issues during host camping events. Do not contact the campground resident manager directly unless the Host Camper is unavailable.

Please make responsible choices, respect the sacredness of creation, and honor the worth of all while you enjoy your camping experience at Park of the Pines.

Waiver and Release of Liability

In consideration for acceptance for participation by Registrant, and any additional campers listed, in the Event, I do from myself and on behalf of any additional campers listed hereby release, forever discharge and agree to hold harmless Community of Christ and its affiliated organizations, lessors, lessees, officers, representatives, subordinate units, contractors, campgrounds, Event directors, staff, priesthood, agents, volunteers, participants, and employees thereof from any and all damages (including consequential damages), liability, claims, judgments, penalties, obligations, fines, causes of action, demands, losses, costs, and expenses (including without limitation reasonable attorneys' fees and court costs) for personal injury, sickness or death based upon ordinary negligence, as well as property damage and expenses of any nature whatsoever which may be incurred while participating in the Event or arising thereafter, and further agree to hold harmless and indemnify said organizations and their lessors, lessees, officers, representatives, subordinate units, contractors, campgrounds, Event directors, staff, priesthood, agents, volunteers, participants, and employees for any liability sustained by them as the result of the negligent, willful or intentional acts of said Registrant or any additional campers during the Event, including expenses incurred attendant thereto.

Photo Release (Optional)

In consideration for acceptance for my participation in the Event, hereby give consent to and authorize the taking of photographic, audio or video recordings in which the Registrant or any additional campers may appear; and hereby waive all right of privacy in and to any of said pictures or tapes and authorize the use of the recordings by Community of Christ for any and all official resource, use or purpose including but not limited to print, film, or electronic media and reproduction or digital representation of every description on the internet/world wide web.
